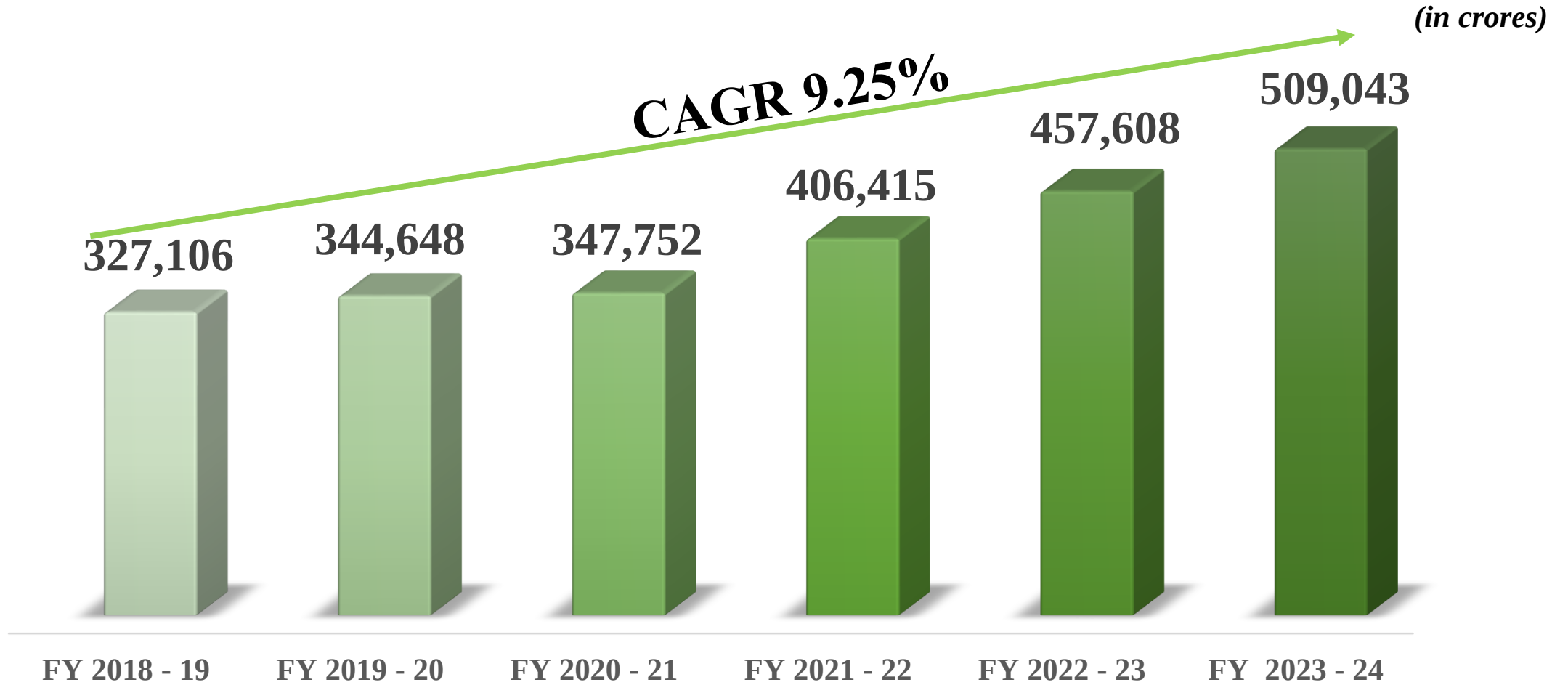

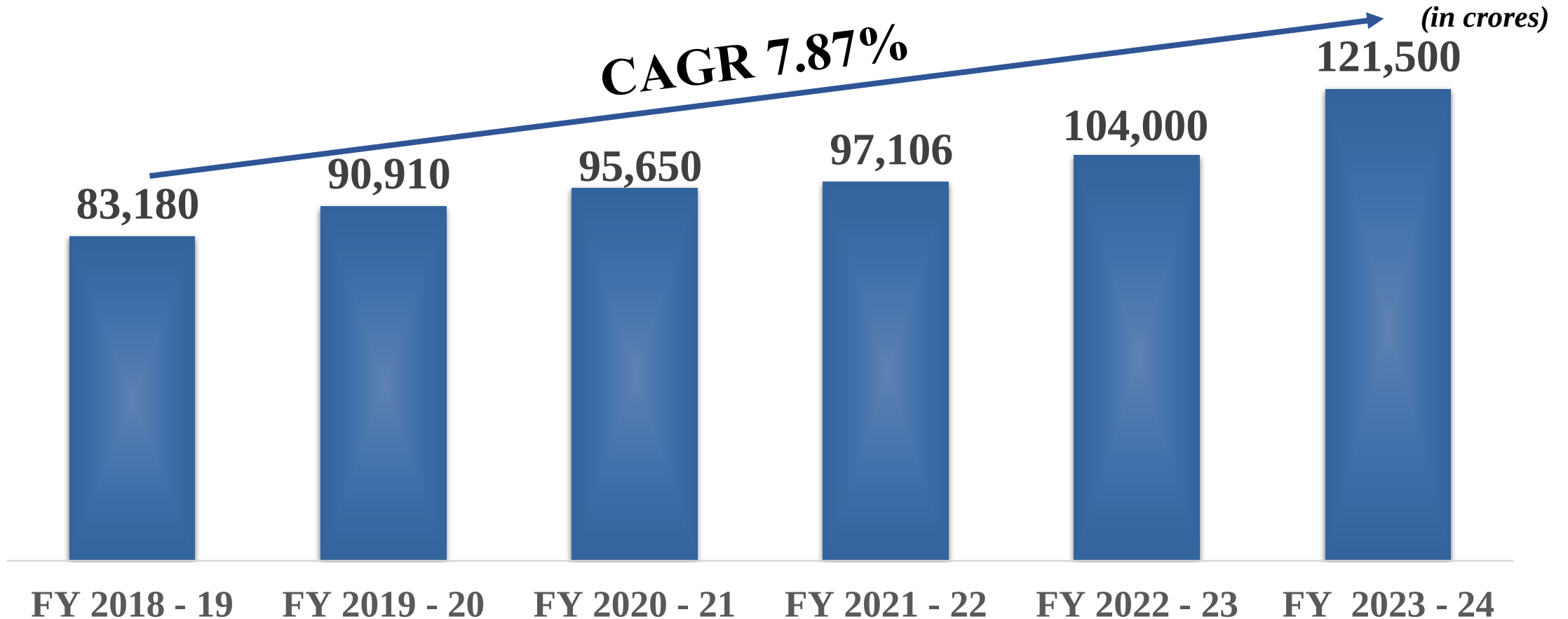


Chhattisgarh GSDP *(at current prices)*

Budget Estimates of FY 2023-24 is **17% higher than last year's BE** (FY 2022-23)



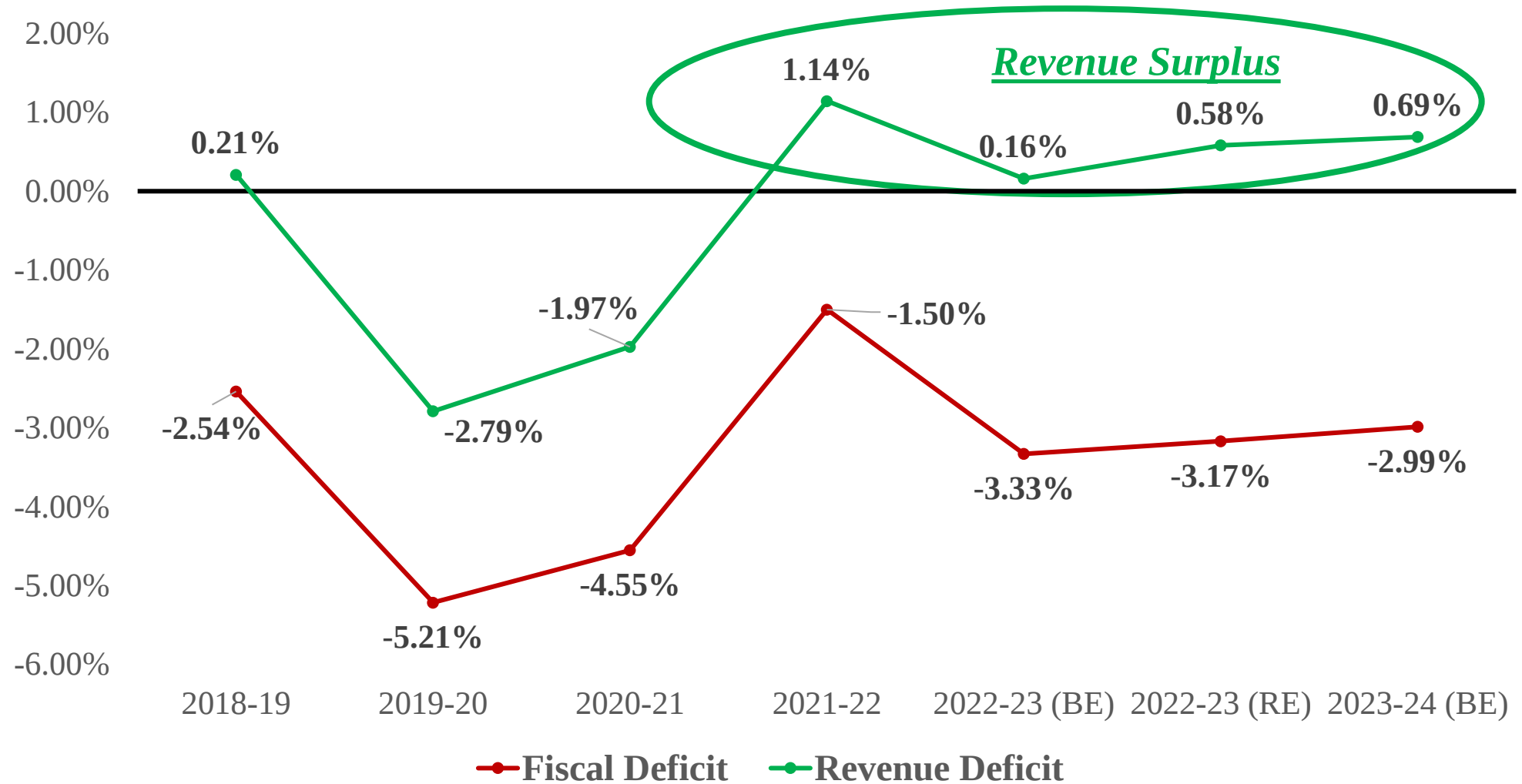

Fiscal & Revenue Deficit as % of GSDP



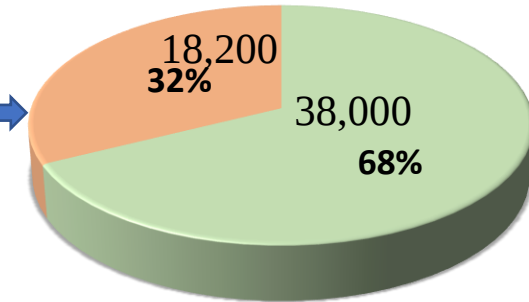

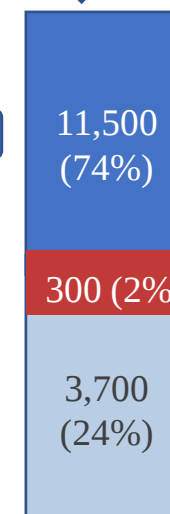

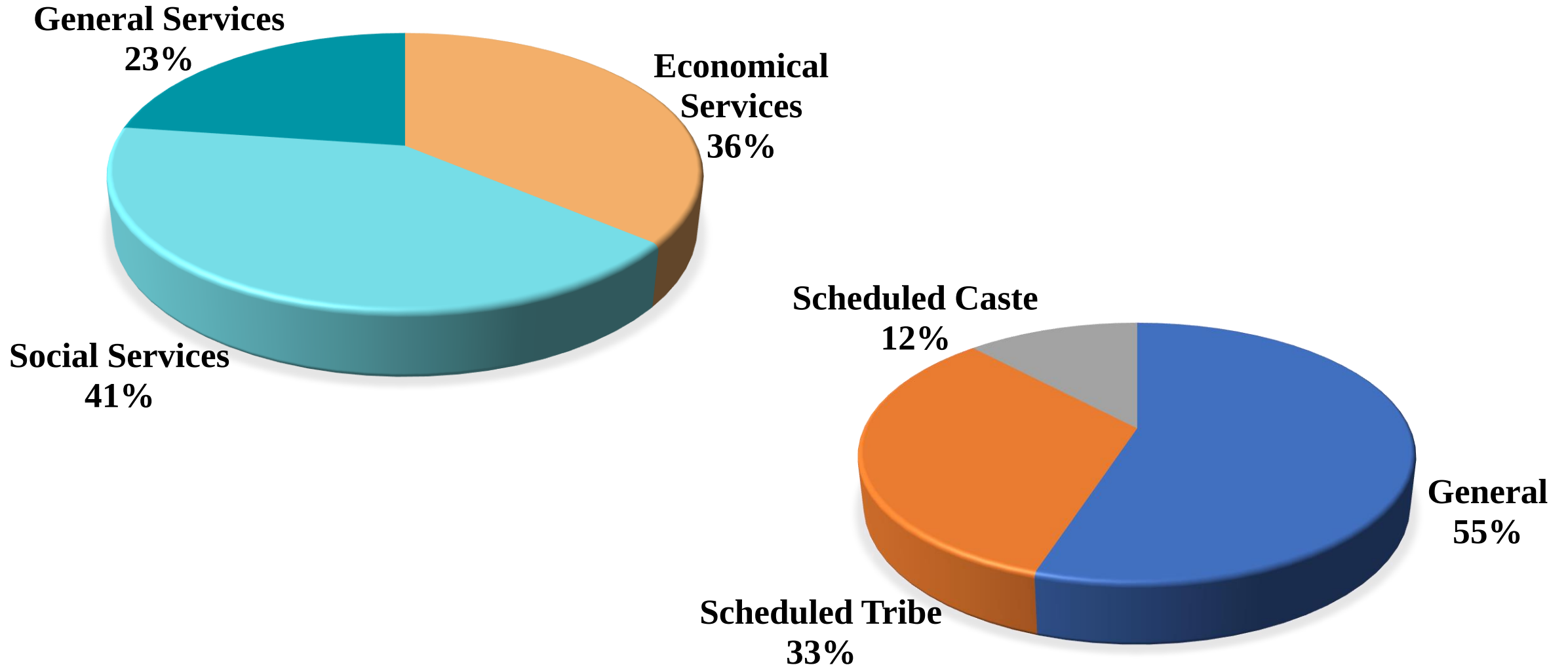

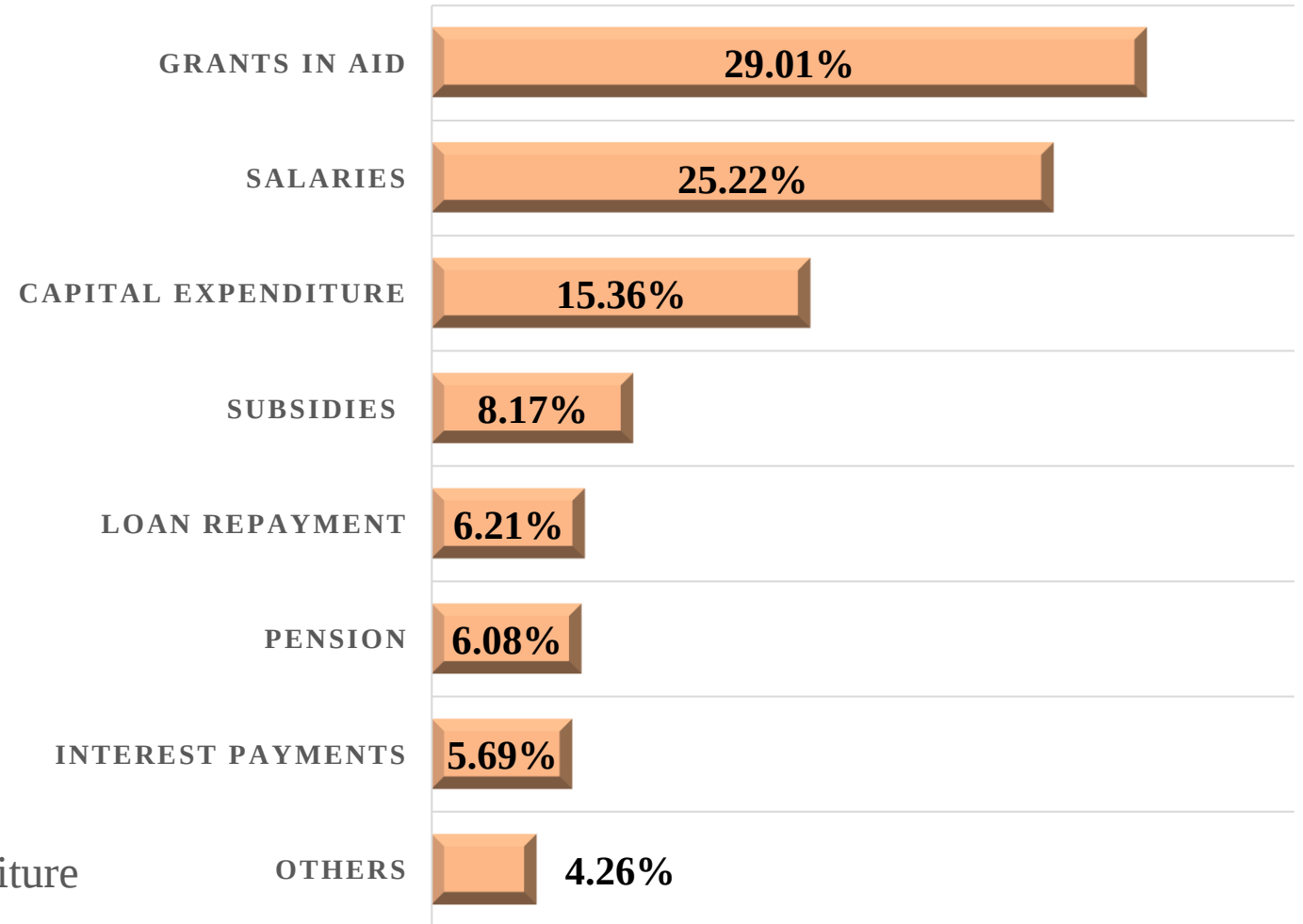
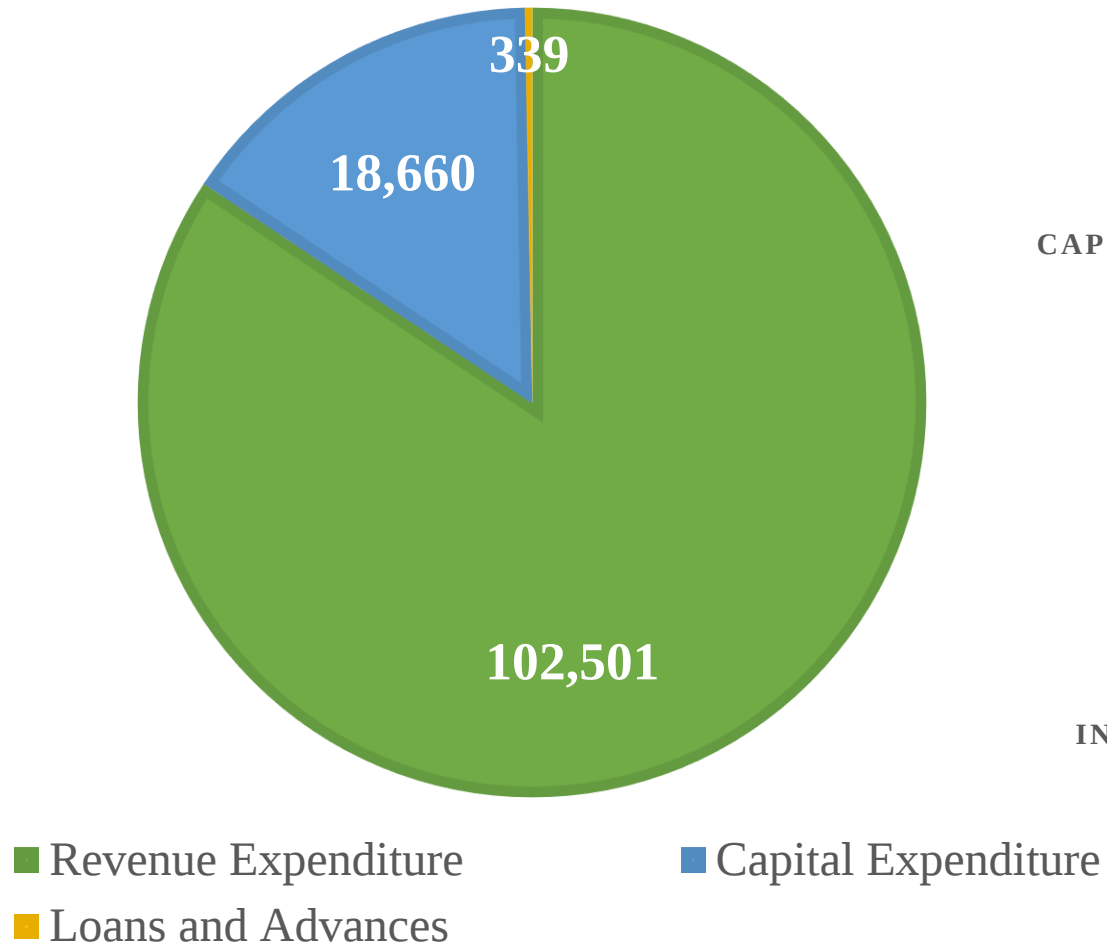
Expenditure : Sector-wise





Expenditure : Nature of Expenditure

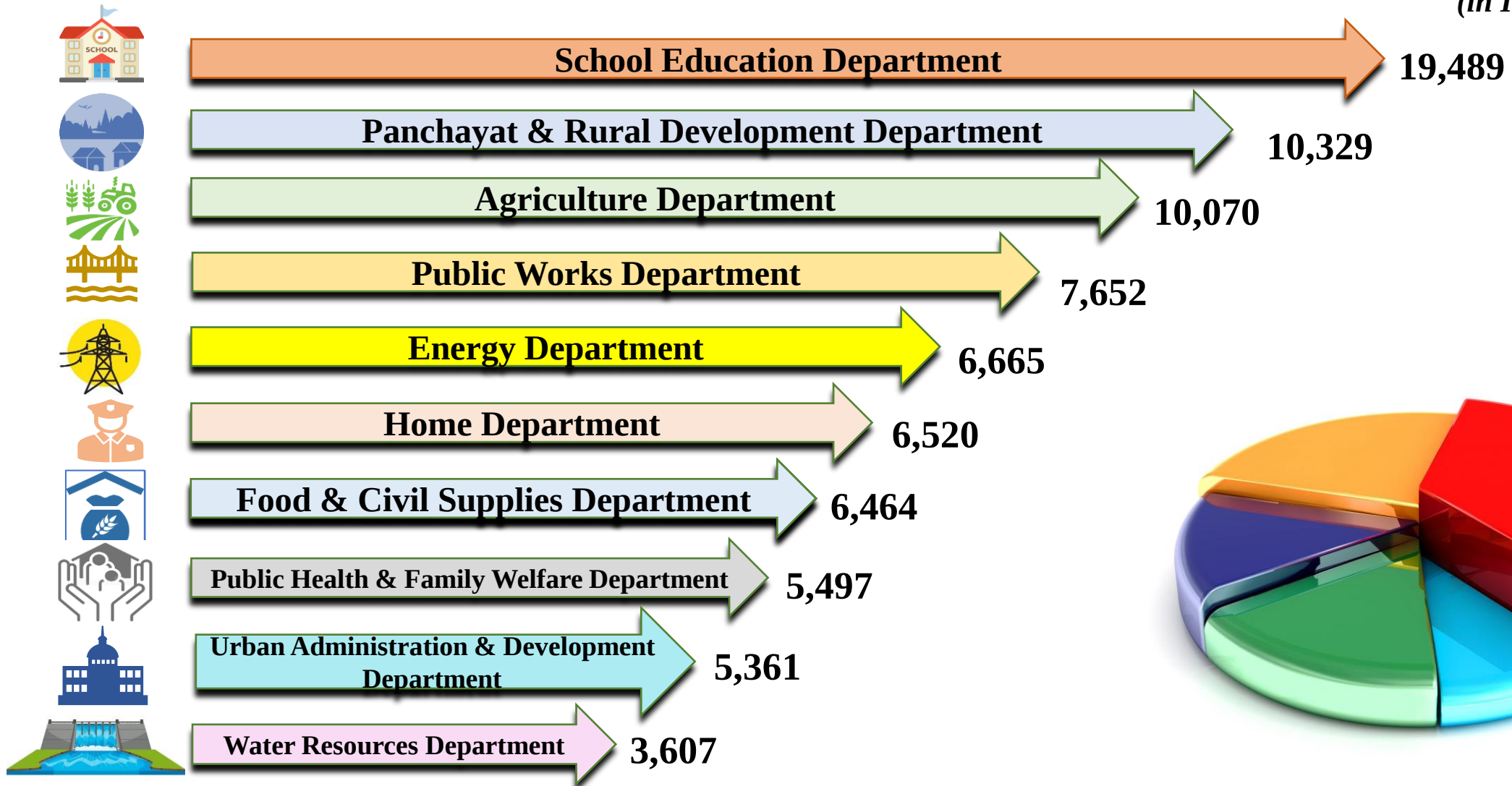
