O R D E R

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner
submitted that even on 29.04.2024, the matter was

adjourned. As a result, the petitioner has not been able to seek any interim order in the writ petition particularly having regard to the fact that what has been seized is areca nut which is a perishable commodity.

In the circumstances, we dispose of this Special Leave Petition reserving liberty to the petitioner herein to seek an early hearing/advance the case/writ petition either for the purpose of seeking an interim relief or for final disposal of the matter.

It is needless to observe that if the petitioner seeks urgent hearing for consideration of the interim prayers, the same shall be considered at the earliest, having regard to the nature of the commodity involved in the writ petition so as to save it from perishing as such.

In the circumstances, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of by reserving liberty to the petitioner herein in the aforesaid terms.
