JUDGMENT

The present Writ Petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:

i) issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, direction or order directing the respondent to accept the arrears of motor vehicles tax in respect of Goods Carriage Vehicle KL-47-G-7868 with 8 monthly instalments.

And

ii) grant such other reliefs as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of this case.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner will discharge the tax liability provided if she is given a facility of instalments.

3. Smt.Jasmin, the learned Government Pleader has submitted that the tax liability outstanding against the petitioner is Rs.1,13,731/-. However, she does not object much to the prayer for instalments to discharge the tax liability.



4. In view of the aforesaid submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to discharge the tax liability on the goods carriage vehicle bearing Reg.No.KL-47-G/7868 in six equal monthly instalments, first instalment is to be paid on or before 16th of April 2024 and the other five instalments are to be paid on 16th day of each succeeding month. In case the petitioner fails to remit the first instalment or subsequent to any other instalments, the authorities are free to proceed against the petitioner under the Revenue Recovery Act.

With the aforesaid liberty and direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
